B EE FF F#F#GG (walk up E to A)

I feel a yawn comin' on

E A (triplets riff: A-G#-F#/C-B-A)

Who yells "get off my lawn"

A (8 beats)

VERSE

A

I look into the mirror and wonder

What's that lookin' back

It looks like me dressed up for Halloween

E EE FF F#F#GG (walk up E to A)

as a gray and wrinkled hack

A

My babies they now grown up adults

C

A young mister and a Ms.

A

I ain't nobody's grandpa yet

But my baby brother is

CHORUS 3

This took me by surprise

The skin is saggin', my resolve is flaggin' and

B EE FF F#F#GG (walk up E to A)

I got bags under my eyes

A

Just yesterday I was young and strong

D A

But yesterday - that's a wrap

A

E A (triplets riff: A-G#-F#/C-B-A)

Tryin' to get an afternoon nap

LEAD – GUITAR SOLO / B3 SOLO (in chorus chords)

BRIDGE
